Minutes of the October 11, 2021 Meeting

Dean Blee welcomed the Council members and thanked them for attending.

#### 1. Dean's Report (Dean Kathleen Blee)

Dean Blee shared the following announcements:

- Kirk Savage, Professor of History of Art and Architecture, was elected to the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.
- Edouard Machery, Distinguished Professor in the Department of History and Philosophy of Science, was

awarded a \$250,000 grant for a 2-year project (2022-2024) by the Templeton-supported "Launching Experimental Philosophy of Religion" initiative.

- Ryan McDermott, Associate Professor of English, received a \$300,000 national endowment for the Humanities award to support the Genealogies of Modernity Project.
- Waverly Duck, Associate Professor of Sociology, won the Society for the Study of Symbolic Interaction's Horton Cooley Book Award for his book "Tactic Racism."
- Corinne Richards-Zawacki, Professor Biological Sciences and Director of Pitt's Pymatuning Laboratory of Ecology, was awarded a \$12.5 million grant from the National Science Foundation to establish a new institute, Resilience Institute Bridging Biological Training and Research (RIBBiTR), that will focus on how nature bounces back after being disturbed by human activity.
- Michele Reid-Vazquez, Associate Professor of Africana Studies, won the Summer Institute's award "Transnational Dialogues in Afro-Latin American and Afro-Latinx Studies."
- Emerita Toi Derricotte, Professor Emerita of English, won the Academy of American Poetry prize for her outstanding and proven mastery in the art of poetry.
- Distinguished Professor Jeremy Levy led a research team that received a five-year \$7.5 million grant to develop a new type of quantum memory for quantum computers.
- Keisha Blain, Associate Professor of History, was selected as 2022 New America Fellow.

### 2. Proposed Lecturer Titles (Associate Dean Adam Leibovich)

Associate Dean Leibovich presented a proposal to change the title of Lecturers in the DSAS to Teaching Professors, as follows:

- Lecturer 1 becomes Teaching Assistant Professor
- Lecturer 2 becomes Teaching Associate Professor
- Senior Lecturer becomes Teaching Professor

Council voted to approve a motion to propose this idea at the Spring 2022 Full Faculty Meeting.

### 3. Election of Planning and Budgeting Committee (Dean Kathleen Blee)

Council voted to elect Haitao Liu, Department of Chemistry, as the Natural Sciences representative for a twoyear term and Gayle Rogers, Department of English, as the Humanities representatives for a three-year term on the DSAS Planning and Budgeting Committee.

### 4. Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Report (Senior Advisor to the Dean Tara Meyer)

Senior Advisor Meyer reported on diversity, equity and inclusion efforts in the DSAS. DEI Priorities for the upcoming year are to:

- 1) Finish and implement departmental diversity plans including:
  - Implementation of holistic graduate admissions
- Implementation of best practices when hiring new faculty
- Update websites to reflect current efforts
- 2) Support, in partnership with the DSAS Faculty Diversity Committee, Departmental Diversity Committees
- 3) Collect information about Diversity activities of Dietrich School Staff and Faculty
- Promote priority actions identified by last year's Diversity Task Force including expanding Hot Metal Bridge program and reimaging the Diversity Postdoctoral program so that it better aligns with our interest in expanding diversity in the faculty
- 4) Work with University to develop a plan to improve recruiting and retention of underrepresented faculty in conjunction with a cohort of other Universities under the auspices of the Aspire Alliance IChange Network.

Associate Dean Brummond also announced that the DSAS Faculty Diversity Committee will be focusing this year on faculty mentoring and will be holding a round table for members of Departmental Diversity Committees (and other

DEI leaders at the Departmental level) to discuss best practices and ideas for improving mentoring.

## 5. Report from Dietrich School Graduate Council (Dean Kathleen Blee on Associate Dean Holger Hoock's behalf)

Graduate Council met on September 14 and October 7, 2021. Associate Dean Hoock welcomed new and continuing members and charged Graduate Council.

Council elected Heath Cabot, Department of Anthropology, as Non-Voting President of the Academic Integrity Board.

Associate Dean Hoock updated Council on a range of issues, starting with current University COVID–19 safety guidance, reported vaccination rates among DSAS graduate students (97%), and changes to research and travel postures.

He summarized the impact of the cascading crises of 2020/21 on students' research and progress toward degrees; the one-year admission pause in programs funded entirely or overwhelmingly by internal graduate financial aid to focus resources on continuing students whose progress was impacted by pandemic-related reasons since spring 2020; the substantial number of advanced students who have since completed their degrees, benefiting as well from additional summer support via the OTP; and the extension funding made available in AY22 to a very substantial number of PhD students beyond guaranteed years of funding. Recognizing the impact of pandemic-related factors on the progress of further cohorts, additional funds have been allocated for FY22, including substantial additional A&S Summer Fellowship funds in programs without regular summer funding. Further funds are being reserved to support Summer 2022 PhD Degree Completion Fellowships. Within the constraints of FY22 budgets, funds to support presenters at in-person conferences have been partially restored, alongside funds to support presenters' registration for online conferences. Financial commitments to equity, diversity, and inclusion efforts, such as the Hot Metal Bridge Program, disciplinary bridge programs, and teaching opportunities in the diverse curricular spaces of Africana Studies and GSWS, were maintained at prepandemic levels. DSAS continues to successfully advocate

for support for graduate students, with attention, inter alia, to flexible solutions for international students; emergency funding; an early fall stipend payment option; and graduate student mental health. This year, Council will consider graduate student mental health and wellbeing with UCC guests in the light of the recent CGS/JED report.

In consultation with the OTP, OUC, OEDI, and PittGlobal, DSAS has significantly expanded graduate application fee waivers to further reduce financial barriers to attending graduate school. DSAS-GS thus further deepen its commitment to advancing access, equity, diversity, and inclusive excellence while maintaining the financial viability of the DSAS admissions and recruitment ecosystem. The one-year pilot will be evaluated in advance of the 2022/23 admissions season, including with DSAS Graduate Council, OTP, OEDI, OUC.

In AY21, the UCGS Subcommittee for Student Affairs, cochaired by Associate Dean Hoock, consulted widely with graduate and professional schools, OEDI, UCTL, and other units to prepare the report "Preparing Tomorrow's Anti-Racist and Culturally Sensitive Leaders". UCGS adopted the committee's recommendations for foundational antiracism and intercultural competency training for all graduate and professional students, with enhanced training for TA/TFs and enhanced exposure for research trainees in collaborative settings.

Since spring 2021, Pitt has been participating as one of six U.S. universities in the ACLS/LUCE Design Workshop for a New Academy, focused on accelerating the reimagining of doctoral training as student-centered, inclusive, broadly purposed, outcomes-focused, and career diverse. Council will be discussing empowering all PhD students to forge diverse mentoring teams and the role of IDPs such as myIDP and ImaginePhD

Council resumed last year's discussion of the Doctoral Dissertation Committee Policy in light of experiences with remote pandemic-era dissertation overviews and defenses. Council discussed further the rationale for student-centered changes to the policy within the parameters of University policy. The revised policy expands flexibility with regard to

committee membership (for active researchers and professionals with appointments beyond academia as external committee members) and extends and clarifies remote participation options while reducing bureaucratic requirements. Council voted unanimously to adopt the revised policy (October 7, 2021) to replace the current, pandemic-era interim policy as soon as it can be formally enacted.

### 6. Report from Dietrich School Undergraduate Council (Associate Dean John Twyning)

Associate Dean Twyning shared the following report from the Dietrich School Undergraduate Council.

### 7. Report on the College of General Studies Council (Associate Dean John Twyning)

Associate Dean Twyning shared the following report from the College of General Studies Council.

Introductions and Updates:

Dean Twyning invited the members to introduce themselves. He reported that a new Disability Studies Certificate would be coming to the council for review.

### **Update to the GPA requirement for the Natural Sciences major:**

College of General Studies Council passed a motion to revise the minimum grade point average required to declare the Natural Science major. This proposal must proceed to Dietrich School Council for final approval.

The new minimum grade point average will be effective for students who enter in spring 2022. Students who are currently pursuing the major and who are not in their final semester may choose to follow the new requirements, which follow.

CGS Student Government representative Jessica Rolke presented a report on the actions of the CGS Student Government board.

Boryana Dobreva, Director of Academic Programs, informed the College of General Studies Council of upcoming activities to recognize Nontraditional Student Week in early November.

#### 8. Other Business

Dean Blee addressed Council on the question of meeting format and said that a survey would be circulated to determine council member preferences. The meeting concluded at 2 p.m.

#### Dietrich School Tenure Council Report of the Secretary Submitted September 9, 2021

Between September 1, 2020 and August 31, 2021, a total of 30 ad hoc Review Committees were convened to advise the Dean of the Dietrich School of Arts and Sciences on cases for promotion to Associate Professor with tenure, appointment at tenured rank, or promotion to Full Professor.

The members of these Committees were chosen by the Tenure Council Selection Committee and the Dean of the Dietrich School of Arts and Sciences in accordance with the Dietrich School Bylaws. In the previous 10 years, the number of ad hoc Review Committees was as follows:

Twelve ad hoc Review Committees were convened to advise the Dean on departmental recommendations that Assistant Professors be promoted to the rank of Associate Professor and awarded tenure. Twelve committees voted unanimously to support the departmental recommendations. The Dean accepted twelve of those committee recommendations and sent positive recommendations to the Provost.

Sixteen ad hoc Review Committees were convened to advise the Dean on departmental recommendations for promotion of tenured Associate Professors to the rank of Full Professor.

Fourteen committees voted unanimously in favor of the departmental recommendations of promotion to Full Professor, one committee voted 4:1 in favor of promotion, and one committee voted 2:3 against promotion. The Dean accepted fourteen recommendations and forwarded fourteen positive recommendations to the Provost. Two cases were denied promotion to Full, and of those, one candidate has requested a reconsideration.

Three Review Committees were convened to advise the Dean on departmental recommendations to offer appointments with tenure to new faculty members at the rank of full Professors and Associate Professors. One committee voted 5:1 in favor, and one committee voted 4:2 in favor of the departmental recommendations. Two candidates were offered appointments; one accepted, one offer is still pending. The ad hoc committees for each of the cases were Standing Committees of the Dietrich School Tenure Council.

The Dietrich School Tenure Council for 2020-21 consisted of 49 regular members and 31 alternate members.
