## Minutes of the Arts and Sciences Council Meeting Held on September 19, 2011 at 1:00 p.m. 910 Cathedral of Learning

1. Minutes of the Meeting held on May 20, 2011

Professor Randall Walsh moved to accept the minutes. This motion was seconded by Associate Dean John Twyning and was approved by the council.

**2.** Election of Arts and Sciences Council Member as Vice Chairperson to Serve in Dean's Absence

Professor Randall Walsh nominated Senior Associate Dean Jim Knapp to serve as Vice Chairperson. Jim Knapp agreed to serve and the motion was seconded by Professor David Waldeck and unanimously approved.

3. Dean's Report

Dean Cooper identified the new senior hires for FY 2012 as:

John McDowell was honored with the Mellon Foundation Distinguished Achievement Award, a \$1.5 Million grant for "putting human nature back in Philosophy". Diane Litman was named to the Inaugural class of Senior Members of the Association for the Advancement of Artificial Intelligence. Wen Xu, a University of Pittsburgh Honors College junior majoring in neuroscience, has been named a 2011 Barry M. Goldwater Scholarship winner for her exceptional independent research.

Three students received National Science Foundation Graduate Research Fellowship Program awards for 2011:

**4.** Report from Arts and Sciences Undergraduate Council (Associate Dean John Twyning)

Dean John Twyning advised that Undergraduate Council has not yet met this year. He did announce that Undergraduate Studies is changing the title of the Office of Experiential Learning to the Office of Undergraduate Research, and that his office is working to hire a new staff director for this program.

Professor Randall Walsh moved to accept this report and all were in favor.

**5.** Report from Arts and Sciences Graduate Council (Acting Associate Dean Stephen Carr)

Dean Stephen Carr reported that Graduate Council held their first meeting on Friday, September 16, 2011, when they held an election for open positions.

He announced that the Hot Metal Bridge Program had nine Fellows complete the program, and seven of the nine went on to enter doctoral programs, including three continuing at Pitt. The program plans to have nine Fellows again this year. Professor Jerome Branch moved to accept the report and all

were in favor.

6. Update on the Budget (Dean N. John Cooper)

Dean Cooper suggested in the last council meeting of May 20 that a 25% cut in the Commonwealth Appropriation was the most probable scenario when the Pennsylvania budget was decided. In the event, however, the University was cut only 21%, including 19% in the general Appropriation that supports the Education and General (E&G) budget. The University responded effectively. Salary increases were not broadly expected given the magnitude of the cut, but the University ultimately decided to proceed with a modest raise.

The University is looking for areas in which to make reductions, but the University also continued the recent trend of increasing student enrollment by 100-200 students per year. Departments were asked for recruitment requests over the summer, and Arts and Sciences is expecting to use some revenue from increased undergraduate tuition to activate second priority positions in areas of priority.

Professor Randall Walsh asked if departments can expect to receive additional TA slots and Dean Cooper responded that that is possible where it would result in increased undergraduate instruction. Professor Paul Shepard asked about the current A&S Undergraduate enrollment, and the Dean indicated that current number, as of the first week of classes, was 10,782. The target enrollment goal five years ago was 9,800, but we have been above that number. Numbers of Engineering and CBS students whom we serve are also up, but CGS enrollments are down.

Professor Delanie Jenkins asked what the current number of T/TS positions is, and Dean Cooper responded that the funded T/TS faculty slots went from 541 to 514 with the 5% cut. Professor Steve Manuck asked about the NTS number, and Dean Cooper indicated that it is currently about 150.

7. Slate for Nominating Committee (Dean N. John Cooper)

Dean Cooper summarized the role of the Nominating Committee and read the relevant sections from the Arts and Sciences Bylaws (Arts and Sciences Bylaws, Section III.13). He reminded Council members that a slate of candidates was to be advertised as per the Bylaws and presented at the Fall meeting of the faculty of the School of Arts and Sciences, after which the Nominating Committee of six members (two from each division of Arts and Sciences) shall be elected by ballot. Dean Cooper outlined the duties of the Nominating Committee within Arts and Sciences and the charge to that Committee. Dean Cooper pointed out that faculty members who served on the Nominating Committee in the previous year are not eligible to serve this year. He also emphasized the importance of not electing two faculty members in the same department. He then asked for nominations from Council of suitable candidates for the Nominating Committee, and suggested that as many departments as possible should be represented on the slate of nominees.

Council members then prepared a rank ordered list of nominees for the Nominating Committee. Professor Delanie Jenkins (Humanities), Professor Randall Walsh (Social Sciences), and Professor Steve Manuck (Natural Sciences) agreed to contact the nominees from their respective divisions to ascertain their willingness to serve if elected.

8. Proposed Open Access Policy (Dean N. John Cooper)

Dean Cooper gave a brief description of the background to the proposed Open Access Policy. Professor Delanie Jenkins asked if this information would be searchable, and Dean Cooper indicated that it will be. The hope is that Pitt open access research material will be a point of reference for experts looking for information on a specific topic. Dean Jim Knapp pointed out that the information would be available for those searching the internet for information on our faculty.

Professor Paul Shepard wanted to know the origin of the proposed new policy and where it would be funded from. Dean Cooper indicated that the idea originated with Faculty Assembly and that it would be funded from the Provost's Office and the library. Acting Dean Stephen Carr asked if this policy would hinder the opportunity for Professor's to have their published chapters build into a book, and Dean Cooper indicated that he would look into that question.

**9.** Set Date and Agenda Items for Full Faculty Meeting (Dean N. John Cooper)

After a vote, Council selected Wednesday, October 26, 2011 from 11:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. for the full faculty meeting in the Martin Room. The agenda for the full faculty meeting was distributed and approved by all. **10.** Appoint an Arts and Sciences Council Member from the Natural Sciences to A&S-PBC to a 3 year term (Dean N. John Cooper)

David Waldeck was nominated and accepted the position. The election was approved unanimously by all.

**11.** Replace Arts and Sciences Council Member Don Bialostosky with a faculty member form the Humanities Division for a 3 year term (Dean N. John Cooper)

The Council took some time to discuss the options and came up with two suggestions that the Dean will pursue.

12. Accreditation and Assessment (Dean N. John Cooper)

Dean Cooper reported that he did not have anything at this time and will update at the full faculty meeting.

**13.** Other Business With no other business the meeting was adjourned at 2:28 p.m.
